NOTICE OF MEMBERS' REGISTRABLE INTERESTS

I, Jenny Whittle

being a Member of Kent County Council (KCC) (and the Kent & Medway Fire and Rescue Authority (KMFRA)) have the following interests which I am required by law, as reflected in the KCC and KMFRA Codes of Conduct, to register:

- (1) Any employment or business carried on by you.

- (2) The name of any person or body who employs you or has appointed you.

- (3) The name of any body or person, other than KCC, KMFRA or any other local authority, who has made a payment to you in respect of your election, or any expenses incurred by you in carrying out your duties.

- (4) The name of any person or body who has a place of business or land in the KCC or Medway Council area, and in whom you have a beneficial interest in a class of securities of that person or body that exceeds the nominal value of £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital (whichever is the lower).

- (5) A description of any contract for goods, services or works made between the KCC or the KMFRA, and you or a firm in which you are a partner, a company of which you are a remunerated director, or a person or body of the description specified in (4) above.
(Please specify whether contract is with KCC or the KMFRA).

- (6) The address or other description (sufficient to identify the location) of any land in the KCC or Medway Council area in which you have a beneficial interest.

- (7) The address or other description (sufficient to identify the location) of any land where the landlord is KCC or the KMFRA and the tenant is you, a firm in which you are a partner, a company of which you are a remunerated director, or a person or body of the description specified in (4).

- (8) The address or other description (sufficient to identify the location) of any land in the KCC or Medway Council area in which you have a licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy for 28 days or longer.

- (9) The name of any body of which you are a member or in a position of general control or management (*specify name of body and your relationship to it in each case*) and:-

- (a) to which you have been appointed or nominated by KCC or the KMFRA (*please specify which*);

- (b) exercises functions of a public nature (*If you have been appointed by KCC to serve on the KMFRA or the Kent Police Authority (where you serve as a member of that body, not as a representative of KCC) you would need to register this here*);

- (c) is directed to charitable purposes; or

- (d) one of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party or trade union).

- (10) Any person or body from whom you have received a gift or hospitality, over the value of £25, in your capacity as a KCC or KMFRA Member.
