Tourism plays a vital role in Thanet's economy. Fran Warrington will describe the work being done to raise Thanet's profile, working with Visit Kent and Visit Thanet to attract visitors to the area and maintain and strengthen its vibrant tourist industry.

There are a host of different events and activities planned for local people and visitors along Thanet's coastline this year, most of which are free or heavily subsidised.
