Themes and Questions

- Please introduce yourself and offer an outline of the Campaign to End Loneliness and its main objectives.
- Who is impacted by loneliness and social isolation? What is the prevalence of loneliness in the country?
- What are the main causes leading to loneliness and social isolation amongst adults aged 65 and over?
- What are the consequences of loneliness and social isolation on these people?
- What interventions and strategies are working particularly well to prevent or reduce the negative impacts of loneliness and social isolation on older people?
- In your view, what are the challenges associated with preventing or reducing social isolation and loneliness amongst older people?
- In your opinion, what more can be done locally to address social isolation and loneliness amongst older residents?
- Are there any other issues, in relation to the review, that you wish to raise with the Committee?
