- Selection and Member Services Paper
- 114 Executive Key Decisions taken in 2021 calendar year
- 49% taken prior to the election
- ▶ 3 were successfully called in
- 17 did not go to a Cabinet Committee (of which 8 were non-urgent)
- Types of Decision
 - Commissioning 44 (38.5%)
 - ▶ Disposal 7 (6.1%)
 - ▶ Enabling 24 (21%)
 - Enforcement 1 (0.8%)
 - ▶ Grants 21 (18.4%)
 - ► IAA (Inter Authority Agreement) 2 (1.7%)
 - → ▶ New Burden 1 (0.8%)
 - ▶ Plan 9 (7.8%)
 - Policy 17 (14.9%)
- Of the 97 that went to a Cabinet Committee, the distribution was as follows:
 - Adult Social Care 8 (8.2%)
 - CYPE 35 (36%)
 - Environment and Transport 33 (34%)
 - Growth and Economic Development 5 (5.1%)
 - Health Reform and Public Health 1 (1%)
 - Policy and Resources 11 (11.3%)
 - Property Sub Committee to Policy and Resources 4 (4.1%)
