(1) A supplementary report setting out revised details of Committee, Sub-Committee and Advisory Board proportionality had been circulated prior to the meeting.

(2) The Committee agreed that the 11 Non KCC Members of the existing Children and Families POC should be consulted in order to establish which of the three new Children and Families POCs they wished to serve on.

(3) The Committee agreed to recommend that where the Labour Group requested a seat on a Select Committee, every effort would be made to accommodate this wish.

(4) The Committee agreed to defer consideration of Outside Body appointments and proportionality representation on Other Authorities, Joint Committees and Partnership Boards to its next meeting.

(5) The Committee made an exception to its decision in (4) above in respect of voting entitlements at the LGA AGM. It was agreed that the Conservative Group representative(s) would have 11 votes and the Liberal Democrat Group representative 1.

(6) The Committee deferred consideration of the Members' Conference Budget to the next meeting of the Committee and asked for the figures to be broken down on a Member by Member basis once the sums for the LGA AGM, the County Councils' Network AGM and the LGA Annual Finance Conference had been subtracted from the overall total.

(7) RESOLVED that:-

- (a) the County Council be recommended to agree the proposed allocation of Committee, Sub-Committee and Advisory Board places set out in the revised report;
- (b) the Governor Appointments Panel be reconstituted;
- (c) the Conservative Group be allocated 11 votes at the LGA AGM and the Liberal Democrat Group 1 vote;
- (d) consideration of Outside Body appointments and proportionality representation on Other Authorities, Joint Committees and Partnership Boards be deferred to the next meeting of the Committee;
- (e) the 11 Non KCC Members of the existing Children and Families POC be consulted in order to establish which of the three new Children and Families POCs they wish to serve on;
- (f) the County Council be recommended to agree that where the Labour Group requests a seat on a Select Committee, every effort will be made to accommodate this wish;
- (g) the list of appointments to outside bodies to be made by the Leader of the Council, once elected be noted; and
- (h) consideration of the Members' Conference Budget be deferred to the next meeting of the Committee.

**Terms of Reference**

1. The County Council agreed the Terms of Reference set out below at its meeting on 25 June 2009.

“This Committee is responsible for:

- (a) developing the role of Members, particularly within their local community;
- (b) keeping the Constitution under review and making recommendations to Council on any changes that may be required;
- (c) keeping the committee structure under review and making recommendations to Council as and when necessary on the number, names, terms of reference, size and political proportionality of committees;
- (d) making recommendations to Council as and when necessary on the political proportionality of the Council’s representation on other authorities, joint committees and partnership bodies;
- (e) the appointment or removal of LEA governors to school governing bodies (*the Council agreed on 20 September 2001 that this function could be delegated to a sub-committee – the Governor Appointments Panel*);
- (f) for making or arranging the following appointments and nominations:-
  - (i) Parent Governor Members of Council committees;
  - (ii) independent appeal panels (school admissions and exclusions);
  - (iii) independent members of Children’s and Adult Social Services Complaints Review Panels;
  - (iv) any other non-Council Members on Council Committees;
  - (v) members of appeal panels in the event of disciplinary action against the Chief Executive, Chief Finance Officer, Monitoring Officer or Managing Directors.

- (g) making appointments and nominations on behalf of the Council to serve on outside bodies (except those needing to be made by the Leader in connection with a delegation by him of his functions, the list of those appointments to be agreed between the Leader and the Committee from time to time);
- (h) monitoring expenditure on Members' allowances, expenses and services;
- (i) overseeing all Member accommodation, facilities and support services, including conferences, training, secretarial and other officer support, and making recommendations to the relevant Cabinet Member, as appropriate;
- (j) agreeing arrangements for Member attendance at conferences.;

## Introduction

1. (1) The Committee met on 23 June 2009 and made recommendations to the County Council as to who should serve on the County Council's Committees and Sub-Committees. Two matters from the report remain outstanding and are brought before the Committee today.

## Other Authorities, Joint Committees and Partnership Bodies

2. (1) The County Council agreed to delegate appointments to other authorities, Joint Committees and Partnership Bodies to this Committee.

(2) The proportionality principles in the 1989 Act apply to the appointments which the County Council makes to various other authorities, joint committees and partnership bodies, as listed below (current appointments shown at Appendix 1):-

- Kent and Medway Fire and Rescue Authority (21 KCC Members);
- Kent/Medway Joint Police Authority Appointments Committee (4 KCC Members);
- Standing Advisory Committee on Religious Education (4 KCC Members);
- Kent and Essex Sea Fisheries Committee (5 KCC Members, but current appointments continue to 30 June 2009);

- Sussex Sea Fisheries Committee (1 KCC Member);
- Adoption Panels (6 Area Panels with 2 KCC Members serving on each).
  - (a) *The 1989 Act does not apply but the County Council's convention is that the 12 appointments overall should be proportional;*
  - (b) *Members should have a knowledge or interest in Social Care or adoption issues;*
  - (c) *To avoid the situation where Members frequently have to withdraw because, for example, they know prospective adopters, it is best that Members do not serve on the Panel covering their home area. It is therefore recommended that Members be nominated by the political groups for service on the Adoption Panels generally and the allocation of individual Members to particular Panels be left to the Adoption Panel Manager in discussion with the Members concerned.*

(2) If the Committee agrees to allocate these places on the basis of *strict proportionality*, these would be allocated as follows:-

### **Outside Bodies**

3. (1) The Committee is charged with making appointments to outside bodies on behalf of the County Council. The 1989 Act principles do not apply to these appointments, but in recent years it has been the County Council's convention that the total number of appointments should be shared between the political groups on, so far as possible, a proportional basis.

(2) A list of the outside bodies to which the County Council makes appointments is attached as Appendix 2. All the outside bodies shown have been contacted to confirm that they still exist and to check the status of the KCC appointments.

(3) The Committee is invited to appoint representatives to serve on behalf of the County Council on each outside body shown on the updated list. In the case of certain Local Government Association bodies, the Committee will also need to decide the allocation of votes between the Council's representatives.

### **Members' Conference Budget**

4. (1) The Members' Conference Budget for 2009/10 is £17,000. The Council's practice in recent years has been to earmark part of the budget for Member attendance at the Local Government Association (LGA) Annual Conference, the County Councils' Network Annual Conference, and the LGA Annual Finance Conference, and then to share the remainder between the political groups on a proportional basis so that they can decide which other conferences their Members should be nominated to attend. The Committee is asked to agree that this practice should continue.

(2) If the Committee agrees to continue previous practice on the division of the Members' Conference Budget, the 2009/10 budget of £17,000 will be allocated as follows:-
