3. **Kent Youth County Council/Thanet Youth Council**

Kent Youth County Council and Thanet Youth Council members will provide an update on the recent work they have undertaken and the local issues in Thanet that matter to them.

4. **John Fowler, Chief Officer, Kent Savers Credit Union**

John Fowler will talk about the services offered by Kent Savers; a financial co-operative owned and controlled by its members and running on a non-for-profit basis. It provides services to the 1.6 million people in Kent, the largest coverage for any UK credit union. It aims to help its members feel in control of their money by providing an alternative to high interest loans or pay day loans and promotes saving with ethical, easy-saving options, including payroll deduction schemes. While Kent Savers' services broadly appeal across the whole community, an important part of its work is to provide financial support and help where it is needed most by offering a safer and cheaper alternative for people with a poor credit history to borrow money.

5. **Nigel Turley, Funding Buddies Co-ordinator**

Funding Buddies is a three year project to assist Community and Voluntary groups in identifying appropriate sources of funding. Nigel Turley will describe the work of a Funding Buddy, which is to offer help and guidance to local organisations in applying for funding as well as providing help with the bid writing process. The project operates through the whole of Kent and Medway, in both rural and urban areas and is available to any group in the

county. There is no cost to the groups who receive support as this project is fully funded by the Big Lottery Fund.

**6. Celebration of grants awarded in 2009/10**

Two groups who received funding from the Thanet Local Board in 2009/10 will give a demonstration of the work they have undertaken and the difference these awards have made to the local community.

- A short performance from John Godber's 'Shakers', performed by young people. This is a project which is part of a two year programme, working with young people from the Czech, Roma, Polish and indigenous communities in Cliftonville.
- Nicola Wood, Senior Extended School Co-ordinator will talk about Thanet's Quartet in the Community and some of the wider community projects the Board has supported.
