MINUTES of a meeting of the Selection and Member Services Committee held in the Council Chamber, Sessions House, County Hall, Maidstone on Thursday, 4 September 2025.

PRESENT: Ms C Nolan, Mr T Prater, Mr B Collins, Mr M Harrison, Mrs G Foster, Mr M Brown, Mr H Rayner and Mr S Dixon

IN ATTENDANCE: Mr Ben Watts (General Counsel), Mr Tristan Godfrey (Senior Governance Manager) and Miss Ruth Emberley (Democratic Services Officer)

### UNRESTRICTED ITEMS

#### 13. The Election of the Chair

*(Item 1)*

1. Mr Maxell Harrison proposed, and Ms Georgia Foster seconded, that Mr Brian Collins be elected as Chair of the Committee. There were no further nominations.
2. RESOLVED that Mr Brian Collins be elected Chair of the Committee.

#### 14. Apologies and Substitutes

*(Item 2)*

Apologies were received from Ms Linden Kemkaran with Mr Spencer Dixon acting as substitute and Mr Andrew Kennedy with Mr Harry Rayner acting as substitute.

#### 15. Minutes of the meeting held on the 27 February 2025

*(Item 3)*

1. It was held that the minutes of the meeting which took place on the 27 February 2025 were an accurate record and that a paper copy be signed by the Chair.

#### 16. Induction Update (verbal)

*(Item 4)*

1. The verbal update was provided by the General Counsel, Mr Ben Watts. The following key points were highlighted:
  - a) Attendance for new Member training had been high and for most briefing sessions, above 50%.
  - b) Group leaders would be notified of the Members who had not attended the preliminary training sessions, particularly around core areas such as

the Kent County Council budget and governance arrangements. The benefits of attendance for these areas would be highlighted.

- c) Some Members had welcomed the opportunity for further development on introductory level items and training would be provided.
  - d) A further programme of activity was being developed to allow Members to move into an intermediate stage of training and this would be circulated in due course. Feedback from the Committee in relation to the delivery of training, development and induction was welcomed.
2. In relation to Member comments and questions the following was said:
- a) Attendance at development sessions and comprehension were two different things: the possibility of implementing a self-check appraisal after a session to check understanding and to reflect could be explored. Suggestions of further sources for learning could be included.
  - b) Members acknowledged the amount of work Mr Watts and his team had conducted in the preparation and delivery of Member Induction Development. Mr Watts paid tribute to Mrs Kay Goldsmith who designed and led the project.

3. RESOLVED Members noted the verbal update.

## **17. Standards Independent Person Appointment** (Item 5)

1. The item was delivered by the General Council, Mr Ben Watts. The following key points were highlighted:
- a) The appointment of an independent person to the Standards Committee sought to increase capacity and ensured resilience by having an independent person available to consider code of conduct issues.
  - b) Mr George will continue to be an independent person, however the paper sought the Committee's permission to conduct a recruitment exercise for up to an additional two independent persons, to ensure the continued availability of the statutory post.
2. RESOLVED that the Committee Members would delegate to the Monitoring Officer the authority, in consultation with the Leaders of the Political Groups, to carry out a recruitment exercise for up to two Independent Persons and make recommendations for appointment to County Council.

## **18. Outside Bodies Member Appointments** (Item 6)

1. The item was delivered by Democratic Services Officer, Ruth Emberley.
2. The paper was taken as read and the following key points was highlighted



to Members:

- a) The Local Government and Housing Act 1989 political proportionality principles did not apply to Outside Body appointments, although the County Council's convention in recent years had been that appointments were shared between the Political Groups on a proportional basis, insofar that it was possible.
- b) It was explained to Members that the Committee previously agreed an Outside Bodies Protocol (provided to Members in Appendix 2 of the report) that provided a framework around the activities of the Committee. This framework was intended to be used as a reference document for individuals nominated and for nomination.
- c) The four Local Government Association groups included in Appendix 1 were politically proportional and therefore Members of these are nominated by the Political Groups. The details of these appointments were being confirmed and an updated would be provided once the details have been made and confirmed with the relevant Groups.
- d) The Aylesham and District Community Workshop Trust had updated their Terms of Reference, which had been approved by the Trustees. The updates included the removal of the requirement for Kent County Council to appoint a Member. The change would be proposed at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting, scheduled for the 25 November 2025. Consequently, the Trust had been removed from the list.
- e) The Rochester Bridge Trust was currently reviewing their Constitution. The Trust intended to remove one of the positions for Kent County Council. There were currently 2 posts nominated by KCC, one of which is currently vacant. The Trust intends to delete the post currently held by Ms Sarah Hohler at the end of her term on 31 May 2026 and therefore the Committee was asked to nominate a Member to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the second, vacant, post to 31 May 2027. Thereafter an appointment to a 4-year term appointment would be requested from KCC.
- f) Efforts were underway to establish whether appointments were required for the Duke of York Military School. An update would be provided to the Committee.
- g) Member interest had been expressed by some Members in relation to Gatwick Airport Consultative Committee and the Southern Regional Flood and Coastal Committee. These appointments were subject to the process set out in Section 3 of the Outside Bodies protocol.
- h) All nominated Members would be provided with a copy of the Outside Body Protocol.

3. Mr Watts highlighted to the following key points to Members:

- a) It was important to recognise that the level of personal liability which occurred when someone was appointed as a Trustee also required a level of indemnity, support and advice to be provided to any individual in that position. Mr Watts confirmed that a wrap around support service would be provided to any Member who took on that responsibility, to ensure that the liabilities and risks were fully understood.
  - b) In many circumstances, Members were indemnified by KCC as they were appearing on behalf of the County Council, but where a Member acted in a way contrary to the interests of the County Council, this could disrupt their indemnity.
4. In answer to Member questions, the following was said:
- a) During the previous administrative cycle, the merits of filling the positions with Councillors from a range of political parties was broadly recognised. While the positions were not allocated as an absolute, proportional, number, the appointments had been carried out by Member discussion and agreement.
  - b) Historically, several factors for selecting Members were considered, such as the geography of the outside body organisation, particular interests or Member personal political preference.
  - c) The Selection and Member Services Committee was responsible for making the decision to appoint Members to serve on outside body organisations. If the Committee made the decision to not appoint Mr Watts to effectively organise this (in accordance with the recommendations) then the decision to facilitate the appointments rested with the Committee to organise. Mr Watts confirmed that the Committee was not bound by any decision of the predecessor administrative cycle.
5. Mr Rayner confirmed that he would like to be considered for nomination for both the Kent Association of Local Council and the Kent Downs National Landscape Joint Advisory Committee. Mr Rayner had been involved with both organisations, in particular the Kent Association for Local Councils, and indicated that he would like to continue in his role.
6. Members indicated their preference to approach Councillors with a clear set of rules, guidance and criteria in respect of the outside body appointments as this would provide all Members with an equal opportunity to nominate themselves. Mr Watts confirmed that, if it was the will of the committee, he would draft an email to disseminate to Members which reflected these terms.
7. It was proposed by Mr Prater, and seconded by Ms Nolan, that the Monitoring Officer would contact Members to explore appetite for nominations to the various outside body organisations; if the number of Members interested did not exceed the number of positions available, the Committee would delegate the responsibility to appoint to the Monitoring Officer. If there were more Member requests than vacancies, the Monitoring Officer would return to the

Committee and set out the situation in a report and the Committee would then consider how to manage multiple applications for a single organisation.

The Committee voted unanimously in favour of the proposal.

8. RESOLVED that the Monitoring Officer will:

- Notify Members in writing of the criteria and responsibilities of Outside Body appointments;
- Prepare an updated report for the next meeting of the Committee with information of which appointments remain to be made. In the event more requests than vacancies had been made, the Monitoring Officer would assist the Committee to consider how to manage multiple applications for a single organisation
- Formally confirm appointments, once the nominee has confirmed their acceptance.

## **Summary**

This report sets out proposals for consideration in relation to changing the number of Committees, adjusting relevant terms of reference and confirming the arrangements for managing transition of required activity.

---

## **Introduction**

1. This report sets out proposals for delivering the work of the Council Committees in a more efficient way and reduces the number of Committees and meetings while still meeting statutory and Constitutional requirements.
2. The Council is required to establish and operate a number of Statutory Committees and in many cases, the Council is required to undertake specific functions. There is some flexibility as to how the Council seeks to manage these and the report explores options to deliver the same functions via fewer Committees.
3. Alongside the review of the non-Executive Committees, the Leader has undertaken a review of Cabinet Committee arrangements and proposals for change are shared in this paper for information.
4. Options and recommendations for review are set out below in the relevant sections.

## **Ordinary Committees**

5. The Council operates the following main non-Executive Committees:
  - Scrutiny Committee
  - Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee
  - Governance & Audit Committee
  - Electoral and Boundary Review Committee
  - Personnel Committee
  - Planning Applications Committee
  - Regulation Committee
  - Selection and Member Services Committee
  - Pension Fund Committee
  - Kent Flood Risk Management Committee
  - Standards Committee

In some cases, the above are supported by a range of sub-committees exercising specific functions.

6. The Committees which must remain due to their specific functions and requirements are:
  - Scrutiny Committee
  - Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee
  - Governance & Audit Committee
  - Pension Fund Committee
7. The Committees which could be amended but it is recommended they continue unchanged at this time are:
  - Personnel Committee
  - Flood Risk and Water Management Committee
  - Standards Committee

**Proposed changes:**

8. Ordinary Committees which may be merged (while still maintaining all required activity and functions):
  - Selection and Member Services Committee & Electoral and Boundary Review Committee
  - Planning Committee & Regulation Committee
9. The functions currently undertaken separately by the Selection and Member Services and Electoral and Boundary Review are distinct but have a reasonable connection to arrangements relating to Members. A single Electoral and Member Arrangements Committee could be established to undertake the all the functions – including making appointments (or agreeing arrangements for the appointments) to outside bodies, reviewing and recommending changes to the Constitution, monitoring Member Grants, determining Election arrangements and responding to Boundary Reviews where these are relevant to the County Council.
10. Selection and Member Services Committee includes a payable SRA to the Chair – this would continue under the proposals, pending any future Member Remuneration Panel review.
11. The proposed changes to the Selection and Members Services functions also include relevant reviews to update the Terms of Reference to better reflect the practical management of some of the elements still referenced in the Constitution.
12. In addition to updating the SMS functions, it is recommended that the Member Development Sub-Committee (a sub-committee of Selection and Member Services) be discontinued. The sub-committee played an important role in reviewing Member Development arrangements in 2023/24 and assisted in the

preparation of an effective Member Induction Programme which continues to run following the May 2025 election. The requirement for formal Committee consideration of these plans has now passed and any required working group activity can be monitored as necessary by the main Committee.

13. The Council has legal requirements to manage Planning Application matters for relevant strategic issues via a non-Executive process. This is achieved either through formal Planning Committee meetings or via delegated Officer decisions. KCC already operates an effective level of delegation in accordance with national Planning regulations and guidance.
14. The Regulation Committee has an important formal responsibility as it exercises functions in relation to enforcement of the control of development under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and related statutory instruments. However, the majority of these decision-making functions are, in practice, exercised via Officer delegation or through ad hoc sub-committees rather than the main parent Committee. The sub-committees determine matters such as School Transport Appeals, Public Rights of Way issues and Village Green Applications.
15. Given the lack of substantive business requiring regular consideration or decision by the main Regulation Committee, it is recommended the Planning and Regulation Committees functions be merged into one overarching Committee.
16. It is recommended in the first instance that the current required sub-committee / panel arrangements for Regulation and Planning Committees are established under the new merged committee.

### **Cabinet Committees**

17. The number of Cabinet Committees, their terms of reference and membership are all determined by the Leader of the Council. They are not subject to formal Proportionality Rules. This allows significant flexibility in how they are managed and the Executive can and should review them to ensure they provide an effective tool to assist Cabinet Members in policy development and in making well informed decisions.
18. The Executive is proposing to consolidate all Growth, Environment and Transport (GET) related Cabinet Committee activity within a single GET Cabinet Committee – this is achieved by the Environment & Transport Cabinet Committee absorbing the GEDC activity and the disbanding of the GEDC Cabinet Committee.
19. The Committee is asked to note the proposed changes to Cabinet Committee arrangements.

## **Meeting arrangement implications**

20. The proposals would result in a reduction (business need depending) of at least 15 meetings per annum. KCC holds, at present, an average of between 120 and 150 meetings per year so this is a material reduction.
21. A reduction in committee support requirements and expenses alongside operational efficiency activity, making the best use of technology and the proposed reduction in SRAs provides a saving of approx. £75k per annum.

## **Recommendation:**

- 1) Recommend to County Council that the proposed changes to the Ordinary Committees (including relevant updates to Terms of Reference and associated Constitutional changes) as detailed in the report be adopted.
- 2) Note the proposed changes to Cabinet Committees.
- 3) Note that detailed Committee membership will be determined via the Proportionality Arrangements via Full Council.
- 4) Delegate authority to the Democratic Services Manager, in consultation with the Monitoring Officer and Political Group Leaders to progress detailed Terms of Reference updates for the affected Committees.

# Electoral and Member Arrangements Committee - Terms of Reference

## Responsibilities

This Committee is responsible for:

- Developing the role of Members, particularly within their local community
- Keeping the Constitution under review and making recommendations to Council on any changes that may be required
- When asked by the Executive, contributing where appropriate to the development of the Council's response to developments in government policy impacting local democracy as a whole (e.g., local government reform)
- Keeping the Committee structure under review and making recommendations to Council as and when necessary, on the number, names, terms of reference, size and political proportionality of Committees
- Making recommendations to Council as and when necessary, on the political proportionality of the Council's representation on other authorities, joint Committees and partnership bodies
- The removal of Local Authority Governors to school governing bodies
- The removal of Local Authority nominees to the Management Committees of Pupil Referral Units (PRUs)
- The removal of Local Authority governors to Academies
- Making or arranging the following appointments and nominations:
  - i. Parent Governor Members of Council Committees
  - ii. Independent appeal Panels (school admissions and exclusions)
  - iii. Independent members of Social Services Complaints Review Panels
  - iv. The selection Panel for the Independent Person
  - v. Members of the Member Remuneration Panel
  - vi. Any other non-Council Members on Council Committees
- Making appointments and nominations on behalf of the Council to serve on outside bodies (except those needing to be made by the Leader in connection with a delegation by them of their functions, the list of those appointments to be agreed between the Leader and the Committee from time to time)
- Monitoring expenditure on Members allowances, expenses and services, and any Members' Grants Schemes

- Overseeing all Member accommodation, facilities and support services, including conferences, training, secretarial and other Officer support, and making recommendations to the relevant Cabinet Member, as appropriate
- Agreeing arrangements for Member attendance at conferences
- Determine requests from a lead petitioner for a review of the Council's response to a petition in accordance with Petition Scheme
- To receive reports from informal Member Working Groups where they do not report elsewhere
- Dealing with all matters delegated to it by full Council relating to KCC elections and the Council's Electoral Boundaries.

# Planning and Regulation Committee - Terms of Reference

- Responsible for the determination of planning applications and related matters in relation to the control of development under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and related statutory instruments.
- Responsible for the Council's functions in relation to the enforcement of the control of development under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and related statutory instruments
- The Committee may exercise any of the powers of the County Council so delegated as set out in the Delegation Table.
- May permit members of the public interested in their decisions to address their meetings, in accordance with the principles of decision-making set out in 8.5.
- Political Groups should only nominate Members as regular Members or as substitutes on the Planning and Regulation Committee (and on any Panels of the Committee) if they have had training in the relevant procedures.
- When determining Planning application and related matters, the votes of each individual Member of the Planning Applications Committee (whether for, against, or in abstention) will be recorded whenever the Committee votes against the Head of Planning Applications Group's recommendation for permission or refusal of a planning application, together with the grounds and reasons for overturning the recommendation.
- The Committee will also consider:
  - a) Appeals against refusal to approve premises for the solemnisation of marriages (or the attachment of a condition to such an approval).
  - b) All Commons Registration functions under Part 1 of the Commons Act 2006 and the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2008.
  - c) The creation, stopping up, diversion of any footpath or bridleway or restricted byway or the reclassification of any public path where substantive objection has been raised or a Political Group or the Local Member requests.
  - d) Appeals by pupils and parents against school-related decisions that are not considered by an external appeal Committee, including transport, education awards and religious education. Such appeals to be dealt with by ad hoc Sub-Committees of Members (Panels) chaired by and including at least one member of the Planning and Regulation Committee. All Panel members must have received appropriate training before taking up their positions.

- e) The discharge of persons who are subject to guardianship, pursuant to Section 23 of the Mental Health Act 1983 on the recommendation of the Director Adult Social Care and Health.
- The Council agreed on 20 September 2001 that functions (a)-(c) could be delegated to Sub-Committees.
  - The Council agreed on 13 May 2010 that function (e) could be delegated to a Sub-Committee (the Mental Health Guardianship Sub-Committee) of at least three Members, one of whom should be a member of the then Regulation Committee and the others to be members of the Adult Social Care Cabinet Committee (who must not also be members of an NHS Foundation Trust). The decision to discharge must be agreed by at least three Members or where there are more Members on the Sub-Committee by a majority of the Panel.

## 1. Combined Member Grants

- 1.1 As part of its Terms of Reference, this Committee is responsible for monitoring expenditure relating to any Member Grants Schemes. Following the financial closedown period and analysis of the grants processed during the 2024/25 period in the final year of the previous electoral term, a report is now available and attached as an appendix.
- 1.2 The publishing of details of grants to the voluntary, community and social enterprise sector is mandatory under the publication scheme (s19 FOIA) and Local Government Transparency Code 2015. Information should be published at least annually; the only exception to this is during a pre-election period, when the information is removed from KCC's website.
- 1.3 Due to resourcing pressures, the report provides a basic year-end overview of the grants processed during 2024/25. If any Member wishes to request further details of any of the grants contained within the report, please email [Members.Desk@kent.gov.uk](mailto:Members.Desk@kent.gov.uk) ahead of the meeting.
- 1.4 A new Member Grant system is currently being piloted which has the ability to provide Members with real time grant spend using Microsoft Power BI. Subject to the successful conclusion of the pilot, it is anticipated that the new system will go live for the 2026/27 financial year.
- 1.5 Many grants were awarded in the last financial year supporting a variety of organisations and thanks are given to Ollie Unthank, Lucy Bigwood, Jenny Leagas, Dilpreet Sall, Georgia Crowhurst, Kieran Hurwood and Janet Kent for their work in processing the 2024/25 grants in line with guidelines.
