Subject matter: K2 Asset Management System Contract reprocurement

Decision is taken under delegated powers and in accordance with the Kent County Council constitution.

Decision:

A decision has been made, by IMT, to re procure the existing Tribal K2 Asset Management system for a further 24 months under the terms of the G-Cloud 12 Framework Call-Off Contract.

Reason(s) for decision:

The K2 Asset Management system is a critical property system used for retaining and managing information relating to the KCC Estate. The current K2 contract comes to an end on 31st October 2022 and it is necessary to reprocure the system in the interim to provide continuity in the management of KCC assets whilst KCC review existing property systems.

Financial Implications: Total cost of £105,082.14 for 24 Months.

Legal implications: The existing K2 contract can no longer be extended under the terms of the original Call-Off agreed in 2018, therefore a new contract will be agreed with Tribal in line with the terms and conditions of the G-Cloud 12 Framework.
