- 1.1 On the 18 December 2024 the Minister of State for Local Government and English Devolution issued a letter to Chief Executives, Chief Financial Officers, Local Authority Leaders and Local Audit Firm Partners on Local Audit Reform: A strategy for overhauling the local audit system.
- 1.2 Included within this letter was a consultation on the potential delivery of local audit through a mixed market, supplementing the private market with public delivery of local audit in the first instance to meet the needs of those authorities who are without an auditor in the current system.
