(Byway Open to All Traffic KH219, Lenham)
(Prohibition Of Driving) Experimental Order 2009

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the local traffic authority in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said act of 1984, hereby makes the following order, for the purposes of preserving the character of the Byway and improving and preserving or improving the amenity of the area through which it passes:-

Experimental Prohibition of Driving

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause any motor vehicle or horse drawn carriage to proceed in any of the lengths of road as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing any motor vehicle or horse drawn carriage to proceed in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article if the vehicle:-
 - a. is used by an owner of premises adjacent to or which are accessed via BOAT KH219.
 - b. is used by a party who on application has been issued with a permit to access BOAT KH219.
 - c. is to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of any road works or the laying, erection and alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports.
 - d. is being used in the service of a Local Authority or Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
 - e. is being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes.
3. This Order shall not apply to non motorised vehicles except horse drawn carriages.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 15 March 2009, for a period not exceeding 18 months.

THE SCHEDULE

(Prohibition of Driving – except for access and permit holders only)

Byway Open to All Traffic KH219 from a point approximately 220 metres from its junction with Faversham Road to its junction with Hubbards Hill, a distance of approximately 888 metres.

Restricted Byway KH433 from a point approximately 447metres north of its junction with the A20 to its junction with Byway Open to All Traffic KH219, a distance of approximately 18metres.
