Reason(s) for decision, including alternatives considered and any additional information
The Academy has attracted a high level of investment that will enable the new school to comprise of first-class facilities. This, alongside the more flexible curriculum and funding arrangements, should result in pupils achieving higher standards. It is the intention that the Academy will also provide improved life opportunities in the local communities. I keenly support the focus on vocational education at the Academy, in conjunction with the more traditional academic approach, as this will produced a skilled, employable workforce in the future.
With regard to public opinion, the closure of Axton Chase School and its replacement with an academy is supported by the majority of respondents to the consultation, including the local member and students at the existing school.
In light of this support and for the reasons given above, I support this decision.
