KINGSMEAD PRIMARY SCHOOL VIEWS OF PUPILS REGARDING THE AMALGAMATION PROPOSALS January 2011

Pupils from key stage 2 discussed their views informally in small groups with the Headteacher. Pupils in year 2 talked about the proposals in their class with a Teaching Assistant.

What do you think about the idea of our school joining together with Diocesan and Payne Smith School?

Most children thought it was a good idea. Just a couple were not in favour or had mixed views – they liked the school as it is or were worried about bullying.

There will be more children in the school and more classes. What do you think about that?

Will there be enough room on the playground?

It would be more crowded but more people would get to learn new things.

There would need to be different class names.

It would be good as there will be more people playing football and sports.

Teachers would have more children to help so we would get less time.

Teachers would find it hard to teach more children and there might be behaviour problems.

We could make more friends.

There may be more bullying.

We could go to different rooms for different lessons (ie setting).

We would need more space.

There would be a lot of money spent on improving the school building and the school site. What do you think could be done to make the school better?

Extend the playground
