#### Decision:

# Reason(s) for decision, including alternatives considered and any additional information

Kent County Council's (KCC) strategy *Live it Well*, for improving mental health and wellbeing, supports the move to providing personalised services which giving individuals greater choice over their support. The move to a Support Time Recovery (STR) service model helps deliver this by:

- promoting independent living
- supporting social inclusion within a recovery model
- providing practical support with daily living
- facilitating people to live ordinary lives
- helping service users to gain access to resources in the community supporting service users to be in control of their treatment.

Informal consultation in 2011 and formal consultation in July/August 2012 confirmed overwhelming support to the move to this model of support. Additionally this will address inconsistencies across the county in both how the current Community Support Services work with individuals and on the currently available levels of staffing.

Following consultation, current service users of the Community Support Services will continue to

receive their existing support, with their needs being reviewed as part of the normal statutory duty to review. If, at review, individuals have continuing needs they will be able to access either the STR service, direct payments or ongoing community support from the Supporting Indepdence Services as appropriate.
