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### 1 Introduction

1.1 This paper updates the Kent Shadow Health and Wellbeing Board on the development of the Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy including undertaking stakeholder engagement.

### 2 Developing the Draft Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy

2.1 The following engagement timeline has been followed since the last Kent Health and Wellbeing Board:

- October to end November – wider public engagement on draft strategy.
- Re write of the Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy in late November, early December to take into account feedback from engagement session.
- Mid December – sign off by Roger Gough, Chair of the Kent SHWB of the final version of the Kent Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy.
- End 2012 – Publication of first Kent Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy.

2.2 Attached to this report is analysis of the initial comments from the engagement process, which is on going. A final analysis of all comments will be undertaken when the engagement period ends on the 23<sup>rd</sup> November, this will be fed into the drafting of the final version of the Health and Wellbeing Strategy.
