Subject: Draft Information Sharing Agreement between the Kent Police and Crime Commissioner and Kent and Medway Police and Crime Panel

Summary: This report invites the Police and Crime Panel (PCP) to consider a draft Information Sharing agreement with the Kent Police and Crime Commissioner.

1. Background

- 1.1 Both the Kent Police and Crime Commissioner and the Kent and Medway Police and Crime Panel have statutory duties that will require the sharing of information. It is therefore recommended within Local Government Association (LGA) guidance and elsewhere, that the two bodies reach an agreement regarding information sharing, the purposes for which information will be shared, and the processes associated with this sharing of information.
- 1.2 Suggested timeframes for the sharing of information within the Agreement are based on the stated timescales within the Police and Crime Panel's existing governance framework or are based upon existing good practice.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 Following consideration by the Shadow Kent and Medway Police and Crime Panel and the Police and Crime Commissioner, the Kent and Medway Police and Crime Panel is asked to consider and agree the Information Sharing Agreement.
