Subject: Proposal to expand The Discovery School, Kings Hill

Decision:

As Cabinet Member for Education, Learning and Skills, I agree to the expansion of The Discovery School, Kings Hill

Reason(s) for decision

The Commissioning Plan for Education Provision 2012-17 identifies the need for additional primary school places in the Kings Hill area of the Tonbridge and Malling District for September 2013 and beyond. In reaching the decision to expand The Discovery School, I have considered the following issues:

- the views expressed by those attending the public consultation meeting on 27 November 2012, and those put in writing in response to the consultation;
- the views of the local MP, District and Parish Councils, the local County Councillor; Governing Body of the school, the Staff and Pupils;
- the Equalities Impact Assessment and comments received regarding this; and
- No statutory objections were received
- the views expressed in response to the Public Notice
- the views of the Education Cabinet Committee which are set out below.

There was consistent agreement that more school places are needed in the Kings Hill area. In light of the responses received to the Public Notice about the school's ability to cope with additional pupils, and in particular the possible negative impact on pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities, I have visited the school before reaching this decision. I am satisfied that it is appropriate to continue with this proposal.

Cabinet Committee recommendations and other consultation

12 September 2012

The Committee considered and endorsed the proposal to the temporary expansion of The Discovery School. The Committee recommended a public consultation on the proposal

18 January 2013

The Committee considered the responses received and the comments made at the public meeting and discussed the concerns raised. The Cabinet Committee resolved to endorse the proposed decision (12/01962) to issue a public notice regarding the expansion of The Discovery School, to be taken by the Cabinet Member for Education, Learning and Skills.

19 March 2013

The Cabinet Committee considered information relating to the responses to the public notice. The Committee considered the information and resolved to endorse the proposed Cabinet Member decision to the temporary expansion of The Discovery School.

Any alternatives considered:

The Commissioning Plan for Education Provision 2012-17 identifies the need to expand Discovery School, and make further places available at Kings Hill Primary School in September 2013 and 2014. The Plan also sets out the need for a third primary school, subject to further housing development. Other options have previously been explored and have been unsuccessful.
