As you can see from above I am very active in local groups and I am also contactable via both Home and KCC on Landline Telephone, Mobile Telephone, Blackberry, e-mail and a live voice most of the time at home address. Add to this a huge amount of surface mail all of which as a Backbencher we have to handle on our own. We do have some very helpful support at County Hall but one has to be there to use them.

Living right in the middle of my electoral division I am out and about most of the time and spend many hours meeting and talking to residents.

Have only this past Friday got an agreement with TESCOS Free Bus to divert to our brand new Medical Centre (Poly Clinic) here in Whitstable. This has been ongoing for almost two years! I am still working with KCC Intergraded Transport Team to get another service (638) to also divert its service to the Clinic.

Have today (Thursday 4 March) undertaken an emergency meeting with Kent Highways Street Lighting as over 70 lighting columns are having to be removed at very short notice. I have personally informed as many residents, schools, churches, hostelries and local community groups that they will be without street lighting for approximately 6 weeks.

I am also a Board member of the Whitstable Improvement Trust which carries out lots of work acting as a trust for many other smaller groups within the locality. Long time member of the Whitstable Society which is very much the group which keeps an eye on local matters.

We only have one Parish Council within the Whitstable division and I make every effort to attend as many of their 11 yes 11 meetings a year as time will allow.

I am not to sure as to just how many Group meetings/Away Days we have held so far this term but I do know that I have so far not missed one.

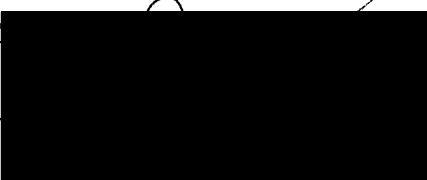
