- There are 7 Clinical Commissioning Groups in Kent; what is in place to ensure joined-up working on the Kent-wide children in care agenda?
- What mechanisms are in place to provide the Kent Corporate Parenting Panel with assurance that children and young people in care's health needs are being met? In your view, are other measures necessary in order to achieve this?
- What else if anything can KCC, and KCC Members in particular, do in order to fulfil their corporate parenting role with regards to improving the health outcomes of children and young people in care in Kent?
