The Better Care Fund

Inflation increase in 2016/17

“New” BCF from 2017 to 2019 increases each year by –

- £ 105 million
- £825 million
- £1.5 billion

Integration of Health and Social Care

- Plan by 2017 to deliver by 2020
- Read across to S&TP
- Coincides with timing on next Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy
