Subject: SCHOOLS APPLYING FOR FOUNDATION/TRUST STATUS

Classification: Unrestricted

Summary: To inform Members of SOAB of the current situation regarding Foundation/Trust proposals

FOR INFORMATION

Background

1. (1) A paper was presented to SOAB on 17 October 2007 informing Members of the Government's encouragement of all schools to consider Foundation/Trust status, and of the 'fast track' procedures to achieve it. These procedures require a governing body to consult 'interested parties' (including the LA) over a minimum of a four week period, before determining themselves.

Determinations

2. (1) Since the last report to the Board there has been two new determination reported to the local authority that effects two federated schools.

(2) On 22 May a letter was received from the **Governing Body of Invicta Grammar School and Valley Park Community School**, advising us that following full consultation, including a Public Notice process, the governors had decided to change category of both schools from Community to Foundation with effect from 1 September 2009. The Local Member Mr Paul Carter was informed.

(3) On 17 June 2009 a letter was received from the **Governing Body of The Malling School and Holmesdale Technology College**, advising us that following full consultation, including a Public Notice process, the governors had decided to change category of both schools from Foundation and Community respectively to Trust status with effect from 9 March 2009. The Local Members Ms Trudy Dean and Mrs Hohler were informed.

(4) There are now 66 Foundation schools in Kent (14 Primary, 51 Secondary and 1 Special) and 91 Aided schools (78 Primary and 13 Secondary) – a total of 157 and in addition, 8 Academies = 165 (92 Primary, 62 Secondary, 1 Special).

(5) For the sake of simplicity, Aided schools should be considered as having the same status as Foundation/Trust schools.

3. Since the last report no new schools have informed us that they have begun consultations
