Stephen Elsden is Chief Executive of Compaid, the leading disability charity in Kent. Stephen has held this post for the past seven years, and before this he held senior marketing roles at Leonard Cheshire Disability and the British Red Cross.

Compaid provides digital skills training and accessible transport to disabled adults and children. It currently runs seven of the 11 Kent Karrier schemes across the county, and also provides transport support to dozens of hospitals and charities around the county. It is one of only 15 transport providers to hold the Community Transport Association's Quality Mark.
