Key decision due to the expenditure being more than £1m.

Subject:

A Proposal to permanently expand Mayfield Grammar School, Gravesend from a PAN of 145 to 180 from September 2017.

Decision:

As Cabinet Member for Education and Health Reform, I agree to:

- a. Allocate a sum of up to £5.2m from the Education and Young People's Services Capital Budget, to fund any necessary additional works or variations to accommodation.
- b. Authorise the Director of Infrastructure in consultation with the General Counsel, to enter into any necessary contracts/ agreements on behalf of the County Council.
- c. Authorise the Director of Infrastructure to be the nominated Authority Representative within the relevant agreements and to enter into variations as envisaged under the contracts.

Reason(s) for decision:

- The Gravesham district section of the Kent Commissioning Plan for Education Provision 2017-21 identified pressure for Year 7 places in the Gravesham area. The Commissioning Plan identified a need to provide up to 100 additional Year 7 places in the planning area from September 2017.
- Every secondary school in the district was considered as a possible proposal for expansion according to several criteria, including location, cost, proximity to demand, site size, willingness of the school, highways issues, Sport England and Ofsted rating. Three all-ability schools have been identified for expansion, but following closer analysis, there is a defined need for Girls Grammar places in the Gravesham area. Mayfield Grammar School is the only option for expansion.

Cabinet Committee recommendations and other consultation:

RESOLVED – That the Cabinet Committee endorsed the proposed decision of the Cabinet Member

for Education and Health Reform to:

- (a) Allocate a sum of up to £5.2 million from the Education and Young People's Services Capital Budget to fund any necessary additional works or variations to accommodation.
- (b) Authorise the Director of Infrastructure, in consultation with the General Counsel, to enter into any necessary contracts/ agreements on behalf of the County Council.
- (c) Authorise the Director of Infrastructure to be the nominated Authority Representative within the relevant agreements and to enter into variations as envisaged under the contracts.
