- Are there differences between rural and urban social isolation? In what ways can each lead to loneliness?
- What strategies and interventions has Age UK put in place to help prevent or reduce the impact of social isolation and loneliness in Kent?
- A report produced by Age UK Promising Approaches discusses a number of case studies aimed at tackling loneliness and social isolation. In your view, what have the most effective strategies been, both financially and non-financially?
- What is the *Loneliness Watch* initiative? What are its objectives?
- What more could KCC do to help reduce the effects of social isolation and loneliness on Kent's older residents?
