He previously served with Kent Police for 30 years; in the last 5 years of service he was the Lead Police Officer on the Margate Task Force. He has advised government ministers, think tanks and directors, and successfully project managed a Department for Communities and Local Government funded initiative to drive innovation around gangs, drugs and exploitation.
