Subject: Proposed alteration to the age range of Greenfields Community Primary School, Oxford Road, Maidstone ME15 8DF.

Decision:

As Cabinet Member for Education and Skills I agree to:

(i) alter the age range of Greenfields Community School from 3-11 years to 2-11 years from September 2020.

Reason(s) for decision:

It is proposed to alter the age range of Greenfields Community School from 3-11 years to 2-11 years from September 2020; this will enable the school nursery to extend its offer to provide places for 2 year olds for local disadvantaged families.

The change of age range will enable the use of School Nurseries Capital Fund (SNCF) funding to build additional accommodation in which the school nursery will be able to offer places to children from 2 years of age. This scheme is intended to provide support for the most disadvantaged children within the local area.

Financial Implications

Capital – The building works for the proposed scheme will be funded by the SNCF capital grant of up to £369,300.

Revenue – The school will also receive revenue funding through KCC based on the number of children in the setting and hours that they attend, through the Early Years Funding Formula which includes Free for 2 funding for eligible children.

Human - The school will appoint additional nursery staff as and when appropriate.

Equalities Implications

There is no evidence that the change will impact negatively on pupils from Protected Groups or lead to them being treated less favourably. The school and nursery would remain co-educational and continue to welcome pupils regardless of gender identity, race, ethnicity or religion beliefs.

In reaching this decision I have taken into account:

- · the views expressed by those who responded to the public education consultation
- the views expressed by those put in writing by the Area Education Officer, the School and the Governing Body.
- the Equalities Impact Assessment regarding this decision

Cabinet Committee recommendations and other consultation:
