Subject: SCHOOLS APPLYING FOR FOUNDATION/TRUST STATUS

Summary: To inform Members of SOAB of the current situation regarding Foundation/Trust proposals

FOR INFORMATION

Background

1. (1) A paper was presented to SOAB on 17 October 2007 informing Members of the Government's encouragement of all schools to consider Foundation/Trust status, and of the 'fast track' procedures to achieve it. These procedures require a governing body to consult 'interested parties' (including the LA) over a minimum of a four week period, before determining themselves.

Determinations

2. (1) Since the last report to the Board there has been one new determination reported to the local authority.

(2) On 30 December 2009 a letter was received from the **Federation of Ramsgate Grammar Schools**, advising us that following full consultation, including a Public Notice process, the governors, at a full governing body meeting on 7 December 2009, had decided to change **Clarendon House Grammar School** category of from Community to Foundation with effect from 8 December 2009. The Local Members Ms. Elizabeth Green and Mr. John Kirby were informed.

(3) There are now 62 Foundation schools in Kent (13 Primary, 48 Secondary and 1 Special), 92 Aided schools (80 Primary and 12 Secondary), 6 Trust Schools (1 Primary and 5 Secondary) and in addition 10 Academies = a total of 170.

(5) For the sake of simplicity, Aided schools should be considered as having the same status as Foundation/Trust schools.

(6) In implementing the decision of the Governing Body of Clarendon House Grammar School, the Local Authority will proceed with transferring the staff and land/buildings to the Governing Body. The school will continue to be maintained by the Local Authority and to receive a delegated budget.

(7) In respect of the school the Local Authority will continue to have monitoring, evaluation and intervention functions, when necessary.

3. Since the last report no new schools have informed us that they have begun consultations
