# AT THE RISK OF STATING THE OBVIOUS....

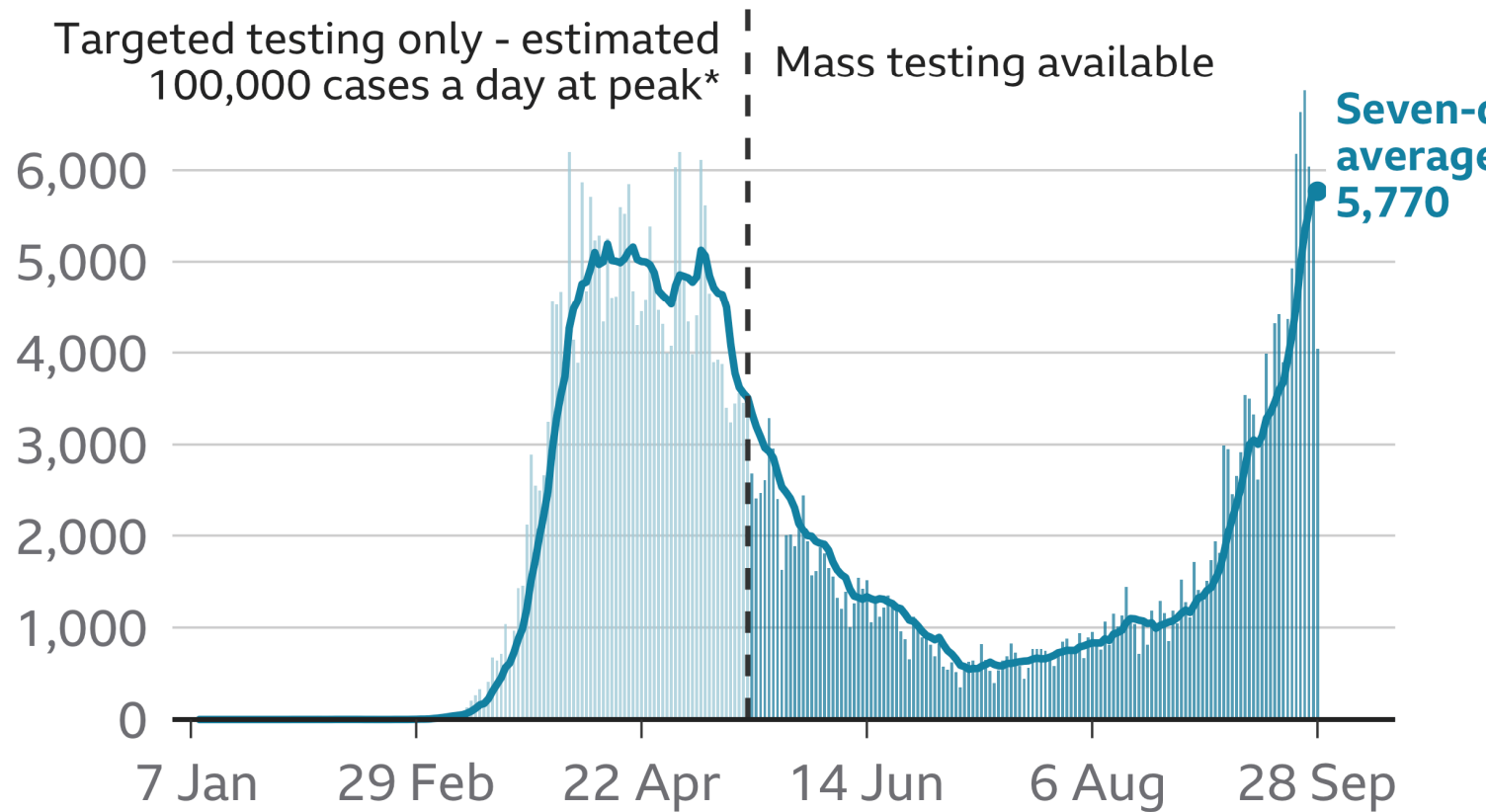
- The operating environment is not currently stable
- We are bound by the statutory and health and safety obligations
- Any future physical meetings (including hybrid) need to comply with of the statutory rules around the conduct of meetings
- There are limited resources (including staffing) and Members need determine what is most important within those resources
- At the current time we are set up to run meetings virtually and resources are directed accordingly to ensure the safe and lawful conduct of meetings.
- Current statutory arrangements for virtual meetings are due to expire in May 2021
