As Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Finance, Corporate and Traded Services I agree to:
 enter into a new Microsoft licencing agreement for 3 years to meet Kent County Council business and Infrastructure licensing requirements; and
 delegate authority to the Director of Technology in consultation with the Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Finance, Corporate and Traded Services, for the necessary contractual negotiations to enter into any legal agreements required to implement the above.
Reason(s) for decision:
KCC entered into an Enterprise Licensing Agreement with Microsoft via its reseller in June 2020 for three years. Since the contract was awarded, Microsoft have made available a discounted licencing arrangement over a new 3-year term. This agreement provides access to a variety of Microsoft 365 applications, tools and modules which are essential to supporting the Council's business operations. As part of this arrangement the Council will be able to take advantage of enhanced licensing which is critical to support its remote working policy and enhancing the security of KCC's infrastructure.
