Government Guidance such as "Valuing People" and the underpinning "Kent Adult Social Services Good Day Programme – Better Days for Adults with Learning Disabilities in Kent".

The last six months have demonstrated that it is possible to provide the same level of Day Service without the main Boughton Mount building and that there are positive benefits to community based services. Whilst a small number of carers expressed doubt and reservations, the majority of feedback from the consultation has been positive and therefore a continued community presence is recommended, in order that people with learning disabilities continue to access and develop a full range of opportunities and networks.

The matter was considered and the proposals endorsed at the Adult Social Services Policy Overview and Scrutiny Committee on 25 June 2010.
