Subject: The Charles Dickens School's Governing Body proposal to expand the school by adding a sixth form.

Decision:

As Cabinet Member for Education and Health Reform, I agree to:

- (i) the governing body of The Charles Dickens School, Broadstairs implementing their proposal to expand the school by increasing the upper age limit and adding a 6th form.

Reason(s) for decision:

- 1.1 The Charles Dickens School is a good and popular school that seeks to provide a sixth form that contributes to local provision and capacity. The school has for some time been discussing the idea of adding a sixth form with other secondary schools and further education providers in Thanet. Both parents and pupils have expressed a wish for The Charles Dickens School to provide opportunities post-16 as an extension of their existing pathways pre-16 and to reduce the number of pupils who do move on from the school and who drop out of education at their destination institution.
- 1.2 The consultation period ran from 25 February to 5 April and the majority of those responding to the consultation agreed with the proposal including strong support from primary headteachers.
- 1.3 The Public Notice ran from 2 May to 30 May and no objections were received.

In taking this decision I have taken into account:

- the number of responses to the public consultation in support of the proposal;
- the views of the Area Education Officer and the Skills and Employability Service;
- the views of the Education Cabinet Committee which are set out below
