**AGREED** to the issuing of a competition notice for a new primary school in Repton Park, also known as Templar Barracks, Ashford.

**Reason(s) for decision, including alternatives considered and any additional information**

The new community being built at Repton Park comprises of 1250 homes and it is forecasted that the total number of primary school children who will eventually live on the estate will be somewhere in the region of 200 to 400. It is therefore necessary to build a new primary school with the capability to expand as Repton Park develops. Given that support for the new school has been given by the Local Member, the Ashford 1 Cluster Board and the School Organisation Advisory Board and that a section 106 developer contribution has been secured, I fully support the decision to build this new primary school provision.
