- Grid capacity and potential rising connection costs due to grid reinforcement
- Off gas areas in Kent and Medway
- Government drive for grid decarbonisation

- Shared agendas- joint approach, better use of resources
- Smart Grids – future stewardship costs?
- Addressing the TRILEMA – security of supply, affordability, sustainability (fuel poverty)

# Possible Action Plan Focus

- Data and strategic planning – LA's, Developers, Utilities – mapping future plans - GIF
- Identification of potential hot spots, or future connection problems
- Developing innovative solutions to overcome barriers and keep connection costs down- funding models e.g. Ebbsfleet , smart micro grids
- Decarbonisation, especially off gas properties
